While in Cape Town, South Africa we encountered incredible levels of poverty including a township of a million people located on the Cape Flats. We worked in a township called Overcome Heights where we were with kids providing a week of Kid's Club activities. Through a group called Living Hope your tournament shirts will be used for an upcoming township challenge between children and youths. Having both the black and white shirts was perfect and even though the sizes were large the kids will love it.

Additionally your shirts were provided to people who came to be tested for HIV. Through Living Hope and other organizations testing is provided free of charge. With the 2010 World Cup in Cape Town your soccer shirts ended up being a huge hit and when the word got out that those tested got a free shirt many more came to stand in line. We had the most tested that day than ever before. Over 30% were found to have HIV! The good news is that Living Hope has connected with each and every one of the individuals who tested positive and have them on Antiretrovirals and will continue to follow-up with them.
